Summer Beach Access to Marquette Park

The Gary Public Transportation Corporation will be adjusting its Miller service to allow for direct access to Marquette Park for beachgoers. Beginning the Friday before Memorial Day (May 27) and thru Labor Day weekend, GPTC will be detouring its **ROUTE 13 (OAK AND COUNTY LINE RD)** thru Marquette Park instead of down Forest Avenue for all service **after NOON on Fridays and all day on Saturdays.**

This routing will allow for boarding and drop-offs at: **Carmella's Café** concession area, the **Gary Aquatorium**, and the **Marquette Pavilion**, providing immediate access to Marquette Park Beach, playgrounds, trails, food/drink and other activities.

Route 13 connects Gary's beaches to the rest of the transit system at the Metro Center in downtown Gary. This route also connects to the **South Shore commuter line** at the Metro Center and Miller Beach stations and provides front-door service to the **Lake Street commercial district**.
