In Gary, we have had a handful of demonstrations. I am proud to say, in nearly each case, our Gary residents practiced social distancing and wore face masks to protect themselves and others during the events.

City of Gary Reopening

We have begun welcoming department heads, managers and some staff members back to work in the City of Gary. Our department heads will make those scheduling and other work-related decisions.
